3 **Resolution approving the San Francisco Juvenile Justice Coordinating Council’s Youth**  
4 **Violence Prevention Initiative: Local Action Plan - 2012 Update.**

6 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Juvenile Justice Coordinating Council (JJCC) was  
7 established in 1999 pursuant to Section 749.22 of Article 18.7 of the Welfare and Institutions  
8 Code as a necessary component under the State of California’s Juvenile Crime Enforcement  
9 and Accountability Challenge Grant Program; and

10 WHEREAS, The JJCC is charged with developing a comprehensive, multiagency plan,  
11 called “The Youth Violence Prevention Initiative: Local Action Plan”; and,

12 WHEREAS, The Juvenile Justice Local Action Plan seeks to establish juvenile justice  
13 directives for youth and young adults, ages 10-25; and,

14 WHEREAS, The JJCC, led by Juvenile Probation Chief Siffermann, Department of  
15 Children, Youth, and their Families Director Maria Su, Deputy Public Defender Patricia Lee,  
16 and Juvenile District Attorney Julius DeGuia, met on July 28, 2011 at the Youth Guidance  
17 Center; and,

18 WHEREAS, The 2012 Youth Violence Prevention Initiative: Local Action Plan sets  
19 juvenile justice funding priorities for various juvenile justice funding streams: the Juvenile  
20 Justice Crime Prevention Act (JJCPA), the Juvenile Accountability Block Grant (JABG), and  
21 the Children’s and General Funds (CCSF streams); and,

22 WHEREAS, The JJCC unanimously approved this Juvenile Justice Local Action Plan  
23 on July 28, 2011; and,

24 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors held a hearing in the Public Safety Committee  
25 on September 15, 2011 on the Youth Violence Prevention Initiative: Local Action Plan; now,

1       therefore, be it

2               RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco hereby approves the JJCC  
3 Youth Violence Prevention Initiative: Local Action Plan.
