Board of Supervisors and Office of the Controller:

I am writing to tender my resignation from the Inclusionary Housing Technical Advisory Committee, effective December 17, 2025. Board President Mandelman's office has contacted me indicating that the Supervisor would like to remove me from the TAC, as I am no longer director of the Council of Community Housing Organizations (CCHO). I am happy to step down making way for new representatives of CCHO to play an active role in the TAC process.

It has been a pleasure working in service to the City and County of San Francisco stewarding this important legacy housing policy. San Francisco has been a leader in Inclusionary Housing for over two decades, setting a gold standard for ensuring that new development provides a fair share contribution to the affordable housing needs of the City and does its part in advancing the goal of mixed-income communities. The Council of Community Housing Organizations has been involved from the inception of this policy, under Board leadership from then-Supervisor Mark Leno, and has been a leading advocate in its evolution and refinements through multiple rounds of legislative updates over the years.

I hope that the integrity and impact of San Francisco's Inclusionary Housing policy is upheld through this current round of the TAC process.
