9	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
10	Section 1. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by adding
11	Section 10.100-368, to read as follows:
12	Sec. 10.100-368. CASH FOR CARE SPECIAL ACCOUNT
13	(a) Establishment of Account. The Cash for Care Special Account is established as
14	a category four fund for the purposes of receiving, administering funds and funding programs
15	for the homeless of San Francisco.
16	(b) Use of the Account. The Cash for Care Special Account shall be used to
17	receive donations from businesses, organizations, and individuals and provide intended
18	matching City funding, dollar for dollar, for such donations. The account shall be used to
19	improve the lives of the homeless of San Francisco, help move people out of homelessness,
20	and provide supportive housing programs with "wrap-around" services such as job training,
21	substance abuse treatment and mental health treatment. Donations to the account may
22	exceed \$10,000 per donation.
23	(c) Administration of the Account. The Cash for Care Special Account shall have a
24	seven person advisory committee composed of one representative from each of the following:
25	the City's Department of Public Health, the City's Department of Human Services, the

1	business community, a non-profit provider of homeless services, a neighborhood association,
2	an advocate for the homeless, and a current or formerly homeless individual. The City's
3	Department of Public Health and the City's Department of Human Services shall designate
4	their representatives on the advisory committee. The Board of Supervisors shall appoint the
5	other members of the advisory committee. Advisory committee members shall serve terms of
6	one year. The advisory committee shall make recommendations to the Board of Supervisors
7	regarding how the money in the account should be spent and cost effective ways to use the
8	money in the account, but the Board of Supervisors shall finally determine, in its sole and
9	absolute discretion, how to appropriate such funds. The advisory committee shall submit to
10	the Board of Supervisors and its Finance or Budget committees or successor committees on
11	an annual basis a written report of revenues to and expenditures from the Cash for Care
12	Special Account during the year covered by the report.
13	(d) EFFECTIVE DATE. This Chapter shall become effective 30 days after it is
14	adopted.
