10	can formally call a statewide recall election regarding Governor Newsom, including allowing
11	for voter signature withdrawals and for the calculation and review of the estimated costs of the
12	election (Cal. Elec. Code § 11108); and
13	WHEREAS, The Lieutenant Governor may formally call for a statewide recall election
14	regarding Governor Newsom, only after the Elections Code's procedures are completed, and
15	that such a recall election must be held within 60-80 days of the date of its calling (Cal.
16	Const., Art. II § 15); and
17	WHEREAS, The California Secretary of State has indicated that this statewide recall
18	election regarding Governor Newsom will most likely occur between late November and early
19	December but has not yet fixed a final date for this election; and
20	WHEREAS, Charter, Section 13.103 provides that the Board of Supervisors may, by
21	Resolution, call a special municipal election and consolidate a special municipal election with
22	a statewide election; and
23	WHEREAS, Charter, Section 13.103 provides that the Board of Supervisors'
24	Resolution calling a special municipal election must fix a date for that election, and the
25	election must occur between 105 and 120 days after the enactment of that Resolution; and

9	Governor Newsom; and, be it	
10	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors will formally call this special	
11	municipal election and fix its date through a subsequent Resolution, as the State proceeds	
12	through its legally required steps for the prospective statewide recall election; and, be it	
13	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors will coordinate with the	
14	Controller, the Mayor's Budget Office and the Department of Elections to determine the	
15	appropriation necessary to pay for the costs and expense of a such a special municipal	
16	election.
