

1 [Accept and Expend Grant - Retroactive - California Governor's Office of Emergency
2 Services - Elder Abuse Program - \$200,000]

3 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the Office of the District Attorney to accept and**
4 **expend a grant in the amount of \$200,000 from the California Governor's Office of**
5 **Emergency Services for the Elder Abuse Program for the grant period January 1,**
6 **2020, through December 31, 2020.**

8 WHEREAS, California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES)
9 awarded \$200,000 to the Office of the District Attorney for the Elder Abuse (XE)
10 Program; and

11 WHEREAS, The purpose of the grant is to enhance the safety of elder and
12 dependent adult victims of crime by providing direct services to victims and bridging
13 the gap between elder justice service providers and victim service providers; and

14 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an amendment to the Annual Salary
15 Ordinance (ASO) Amendment; and

16 WHEREAS, The grant includes a required match of 20% of the project budget or
17 \$50,000; the source of matching funds is the District Attorney's Office general fund;
18 and

19 WHEREAS, The grant includes provision for indirect costs of \$21,314; now,
20 therefore, be it

21 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Office of the
22 District Attorney to retroactively accept and expend, on behalf of the City and County
23 of San Francisco, a grant from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services
24 for the Elder Abuse Program in the amount of \$200,000.
