4 WHEREAS, The Eighth Presidents Cup will be held at Harding Park Golf Course  
5 October 6-11; and,

6 WHEREAS, The Presidents Cup has previously been held in Australia, Canada, South  
7 Africa, and Virginia; and,

8 WHEREAS, The Presidents Cup is a biennial, team match play competition between  
9 the United States and the world's best non European players; and,

10 WHEREAS, President Barack Obama is the Honorary Chairman of the 2009  
11 Presidents Cup, following in the footsteps of other Honorary Chairman at previous events:  
12 President Gerald Ford, President George H.W. Bush, President Bill Clinton, Australian Prime  
13 Minister John Howard, Thabo Mbeki, President of the Republic of South Africa, and Canadian  
14 Prime Minister Stephen Harper; and,

15 WHEREAS, Over the course of the week, nearly 100,000 spectators are expected to  
16 descend upon San Francisco's Harding Park Golf Course, the first publicly owned golf course  
17 to host this tournament; and,

18 WHEREAS, Millions of dollars in prize money will be generated and awarded for  
19 charitable purposes, upon the completion of the event; and,

20 WHEREAS, The Presidents Cup will provide exposure to Harding Park and San  
21 Francisco, via television and the internet, in over 200 countries around the world; now  
22 therefore be it

23 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco  
24 does hereby welcome The Presidents Cup to Harding Park Golf Course.
