"Port and City agree to indemnify, defend and hold Carrier, its vessels, owners or agents harmless from and against any and all losses, expensed, claims, actions, or liabilities to the extent the same is caused by the negligence or willful misconduct of Port or City".

WHEREAS, In Resolution No. 98-120, The San Francisco Port Commission authorized the Executive Director to sign the Marine Terminal Agreement with Mexican Line Limited, pending approval of the Board of Supervisors, a copy of Resolution 98-120 and the Marine Terminal
