

1 [Training grant to promote and advance cultural competency in Departmental programs.]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH) to**  
4 **accept retroactively and expend a new grant in the amount of \$121,047 from The**  
5 **California Endowment for training to advance cultural competency, and to enter into an**  
6 **agreement for the use of these funds; for the period of April 1, 2005, to March 31, 2006.**

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8 WHEREAS, SFDPH has applied for and been awarded a training grant from The  
9 California Endowment in the amount of \$121,047 to promote and advance cultural  
10 competency in Departmental programs; and,

11 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, The California Endowment  
12 requires the City to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with  
13 the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. \_\_\_\_\_, which is hereby declared  
14 to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

15 WHEREAS, This Resolution requires expedited review by the Board of Supervisors  
16 because the award was not received from The California Endowment until after the grant start  
17 date of April 1, 2005; and,

18 WHEREAS, Resolutions authorizing the acceptance and expenditure of grant funds  
19 may be placed automatically on the consent agendas in committee, as they are usually  
20 considered to be routine items, and this resolution authorizes the acceptance and expenditure  
21 of grant funding; and,

22 WHEREAS, The grant budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$4,412; now,  
23 therefore, be it

24 RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept retroactively and  
25 expend a grant in the amount of \$121,047 from The California Endowment; and, be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend the  
2 grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Agreement pursuant to San  
3 Francisco Administrative Code section 10-170-1; and, be it

4 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the  
5 agreement on behalf of the City.
