

[Accept and Expend Grant - Retroactive - California Department of Insurance - Organized Automobile Fraud Activity Interdiction Program - FY2024-2025 and FY2025-2026 - \$1,192,890]

Ordinance retroactively authorizing the Office of the District Attorney to accept and expend a grant from the California Department of Insurance to fund the Organized Automobile Fraud Activity Interdiction Program in the amount of \$1,192,890 for the grant period of July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2027; and amending Ordinance No. 191-24 (Annual Salary Ordinance File No. 240596 for Fiscal Years (FYs) 2024-2025 and 2025-2026) to provide for the addition of one grant-funded position in Class 8550 District Attorney's Investigator-SFERS (FTE 1.0) for the grant agreement period of July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2027.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. Findings.

(a) The Office of the District Attorney was awarded \$1,192,890 by the California Department of Insurance to support coordinated program efforts targeted at the investigation and prosecution of organized automobile fraud activity.

(b) The funding award, totaling \$1,192,890, includes \$397,630 for each of fiscal years 2024-2025, 2025-2026, and 2026-2027.

(c) The funding source is the Organized Automobile Fraud Activity Interdiction

1 Program, established under Section 1874.8 of the California Insurance Code, and under Title
2 10, Section 2698.70 et seq. of the California Code of Regulations.

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4 Section 2. Retroactive authorization to accept and expend grant funds.

5 (a) The Board of Supervisors hereby retroactively authorizes the Office of the District
6 Attorney to accept and expend, on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, California
7 Department of Insurance grant funds in the amount of \$1,192,890 to support coordinated
8 program efforts targeted at the investigation and prosecution of organized automobile fraud
9 activity.

10 (b) The Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Office of the District Attorney to
11 receive more or less money than the awarded amount of \$1,192,890 and approves the
12 acceptance and expenditure by the Office of the District Attorney of the additional or reduced
13 money.

14 (c) The District Attorney of the City and County of San Francisco is authorized,
15 on behalf of the Board of Supervisors, to submit the proposal to the California Department of
16 Insurance and is authorized to execute the Grant Award Agreement, included in Board of
17 Supervisors File No. 241117, and to execute any extensions or amendments thereof.

18 (d) The grant funds received thereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures
19 controlled by this body.

20 (e) Any liability arising out of the performance of the Grant Award Agreement, including
21 civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the
22 authorizing agency; the State of California and the California Department of Insurance
23 disclaim responsibility for any such liability.

24 (f) The total personnel budget for the one (1) new position (1.0 FTE) and one (1)

current part-time position (0.38 FTE) is \$892,473 of the total grant award of \$1,192,890 for the term July 1, 2024, to June 30, 2027. The balance of the \$1,192,890 grant award is allocated to pay \$69,090 for indirect costs, \$17,000 for outreach, \$15,000 for audit expense, \$101,357 for facility rental, \$8,009 for vehicle fuel and maintenance, and \$20,776 for travel/training, and \$69,185 for vehicle purchase.

Section 3. Grant funded positions: Amendment to Fiscal Year 2024-2025 and Fiscal Year 2025-2026 Annual Salary Ordinance.




