

1 [Memorandum of Understanding - Service Employees International Union, Local 1021 -
2 Amendment No. 3]

3 **Ordinance adopting and implementing the Third Amendment to the 2022-2024**
4 **Memorandum of Understanding between the City and County of San Francisco and**
5 **Service Employees International Union Local 1021, effective July 1, 2023, to amend the**
6 **compensation provision for 8238 Public Safety Communications Dispatcher and 8239**
7 **Senior Police Communications Dispatcher to provide an additional sixth salary step to**
8 **both classifications.**

16 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

17 Section 1. The Board of Supervisors hereby adopts and implements the Third
18 Amendment to the 2022-2024 Memorandum of Understanding (“MOU”) between the City and
19 County of San Francisco and Service Employees International Union. Local 1021, effective
20 July 1, 2023, to amend the compensation provision for 8238 Public Safety Communications
21 Dispatcher and 8239 Senior Police Communications Dispatcher to provide an additional sixth
22 salary step to both classifications.

23 The Third Amendment to the MOU so implemented is on file with the Clerk of the
24 Board of Supervisors in Board File No. 230565.

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1 Section 2. The Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Department of Human
2 Resources to make non-substantive ministerial or administrative corrections to the MOU.
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4 Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon enactment.
5 Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the ordinance
6 unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board of
7 Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.
