WHEREAS, Section 9.101 of the City Charter authorizes the Mayor and Board of Supervisors by Resolution to determine in an even-numbered fiscal year that the upcoming budgetary cycle shall be a fixed budgetary cycle for some or all City Departments; and

WHEREAS, In a fixed budgetary cycle, the Board of Supervisors does not adopt a new budget for the second fiscal year of the cycle, but may adjust the second-year budget if certain conditions are met; and

WHEREAS, Section 9.101 of the City Charter requires that the Resolution declaring that an upcoming budgetary cycle shall be fixed also include a definition of the term "significant increases or decreases in revenues or expenditures" and set deadlines for the Controller to submit a report identifying such increases or decreases and for the Mayor to submit to the Board a proposed amendment to the biennial budget; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the upcoming budgetary cycle for these departments: Airport, Port, and Public Utilities Commission; shall be a fixed budgetary cycle in which the biennial budget will remain in effect for the two fiscal years ending June 30, 2027, and June 30, 2028; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That "significant increases or decreases in revenues" in the following funds shall be defined as a greater than five percent increase or decrease between the adopted and projected revenues for the second year of each of these departments'

3	FURTHER RESOLVED, That "significant increases or decreases in revenues" in the
4	General Fund shall be defined as a greater than two and one half percent increase or

7	FURTHER RESOLVED, That "significant increases or decreases in expenditures" sha
8	be defined as those expenditure increases or decreases required to address the significant
9	increases or decreases in revenue as defined above; and, be it
10	FURTHER RESOLVED, That no later than May 1, 2027, the Controller will submit to
11	the Mayor and the Board of Supervisors a report stating whether the Controller projects that
12	the funds for the Airport, Port, and Public Utilities Commission, will experience significant
13	increases or decreases in revenues or expenditures, as defined in this Resolution, during the
14	second year of the budgetary cycle, and will update that report as additional information
15	becomes available; and, be it
16	FURTHER RESOLVED, That no later than June 1, 2027, the Mayor will submit to the
17	Board of Supervisors a proposed budget amendment to the biennial budget responding to the
18	Controller's report.
