11	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

13	Section 1. Chapter 5 of the Administrative Code is hereby amended by revising Article
14	XVIII, Sections 5.18-3 and 5.18-5, to read as follows:
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16	SEC. 5.18-3. PURPOSE AND DUTIES.
17	The Graffiti Advisory Board shall have the duty to:
18	(a) Prepare and submit to the Board of Supervisors and the Mayor a report every six
19	months year on graffiti as it affects neighborhoods and the downtown area of San Francisco,
20	which shall include a review and evaluation of the services and programs in place to respond
21	to graffiti, prevention strategies, and recommendations and plans as to a consolidated
22	program of public and private efforts;

24	SEC. 5.18-6. SUNSET DATE.
25	

1	Unless the Board of Supervisors by ordinance extends the term of the Advisory Board,
2	this Article XVIII shall expire by operation of law, and the Advisory Board shall terminate, $\frac{three}{t}$
3	years after the effective date of Ordinance No. 11-16-on March 1, 2022. After that date, the City
4	Attorney shall cause this Article to be removed from the Administrative Code.
5	
6	Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after
7	enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the
8	ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board
9	of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.
10	
11	Section 3. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors
12	intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles,
13	numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal
14	Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment
15	additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under
16	the official title of the ordinance.
