[Administrative Code - Naming Terminal 1 at the San Francisco International Airport After Harvey Milk]

Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to name Terminal 1 of the San Francisco International Airport after former Supervisor Harvey Milk.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. Findings

- (a) Harvey Milk was the first openly gay elected official in San Francisco, elected to the Board of Supervisors in 1977, and serving until his tragic death in 1978. He is a human rights leader known all over the world for his work in fighting discrimination against the LGBT community, as well as speaking out for migrant farm workers, low-income tenants, the labor movement, homeless youth in the Castro, and many others. He believed strongly that we have to give hope to young people who still (as in Milk's day) suffer bullying in schoolyards, anti-gay violence from family and others, and psychological damage from growing up in a homophobic and transphobic society.
- (b) In order to honor one of the nation's great gay leaders, raise awareness of the history of the LGBT movement, and give hope to young LGBT people in cities everywhere, the Board of Supervisors finds it fitting that a terminal at the San Francisco International Airport be named in honor of Harvey Milk.
- (c) The San Francisco International Airport has four terminals, currently referred to as Terminal 1, Terminal 2, Terminal 3, and the International Terminal. At its June 26, 2017

meeting, the Airport Facilities Naming Advisory Committee voted to recommend that Terminal 1 be named for Harvey Milk. Terminal 1 is currently being reconstructed, and when it reopens in 2022, will set a new standard in style and efficiency for airports.

Section 2. The Administrative Code is hereby amended by adding Section 2A.174, to read as follows:

SEC. 2A.174. NAMING TERMINAL 1 OF THE SAN FRANCISCO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT FOR HARVEY MILK.

- (a) Terminal 1 of the San Francisco International Airport shall be named for Harvey Milk.
- (b) By no later than December 1, 2018, the Director of the Airport shall submit a report to the Board of Supervisors and the Mayor describing the steps the Airport has taken and plans to take to implement this Section 2A.174 and publicize the name of the terminal.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.
