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3	Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH) to	
4	accept and expend retroactively a grant in the amount of \$175,426.20 from the	
5	California Department of Health Services (CDHS) for mosquito control to mitigate the	
6	threat of West Nile virus transmission, and to enter into an agreement for the use of	
7	these funds; for the period of July 1, 2005 to June 30, 2006.

9	WHEREAS, SFDPH has been awarded a grant from CDHS in the amount of	
10	\$175,426.20 for mosquito control to mitigate the threat of West Nile virus transmission; and,	
11	WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, CDHS requires the City to	
12	enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), consisting of the SFDPH Application to the CDHS	
13	for these funds, including Forms A and B of that Application, which are on file with the Clerk of	
14	the Board of Supervisors in File No, which is hereby declared to be a part	
15	of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,	
16	WHEREAS, This Resolution requires expedited review by the Board of Supervisors	
17	because notification of the award was not received by the SFDPH until July 27, 2005, and the	
18	start date for the grant is July 1, 2005; and,	
19	WHEREAS, Resolutions authorizing the acceptance and expenditure of grant funds	
20	may be placed automatically on consent agendas in committee, as they are usually	
21	considered to be routine items, and this resolution authorizes the acceptance and expenditure	
22	of grant funding; and,	
23	WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budget; now,	

therefore, be it

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1	RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend retroactively a		
2	grant in the amount of \$175,426.20 from CDHS; and, be it		
3	FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend the		
4	grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Agreement pursuant to San		
5	Francisco Administrative Code section 10-170-1; and, be it		
6	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the		
7	agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it		
8	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the positions		
9	funded under this agreement as "G" or grant-funded positions which would terminate when		
10	the agreement expires.
