1	[AGREEMENT FOR SECURITY INFORMATION EXCHANGE NETWORK]

3	Resolution authorizing the Director of Transportation to execute an agreement between
4	the Federal Bureau of Investigations (FBI) and the City and County of San Francisco,
5	enabling the Municipal Transportation Agency to participate in the Federal
6	Government's cooperative known as InfraGard, which allows for the exchange of
7	security information between the Federal Government and major transit agencies.
8	WHEREAS, The Federal Transit Administration (FTA) completed a nationwide security
9	assessment of transit agencies and has requested that major agencies, including Muni, join
10	InfraGard – the Federal Government's security information exchange network cooperative that
11	will allow the nations 36 largest transit agencies to rapidly share timely and sensitive security
12	information to facilitate secure communications related to the safety and protection of national
13	transportation infrastructure; and,
14	WHEREAS, The FTA has entered into a cooperative relationship with the FBI to use
15	the InfraGard cooperative; and,
16	WHEREAS, The Municipal Transportation Agency believes that participation in the
17	InfraGard cooperative is in the best interest of the City and desires to enter into an agreement
18	with the federal government (the InfraGard Agreement) that would enable the City to
19	participate; and,
20	WHEREAS, A copy of the InfraGard Agreement is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
21	Supervisors in File No, which agreement is incorporated herein and made
22	part hereof as though full set forth herein; and,
23	WHEREAS, The InfraGard Agreement provides that the City would agree never to
24	institute, initiate, prosecute or in any way aid in any demand, action, suit, or claim against any
25	InfraGard participant, the US, its agencies, officers, employees, agents, advisors, contractors,

1	or subcontractors arising from or in connection with any report or reporting or use of
2	information in accordance with the Federal Government's InfraGard agreement with the City
3	or other entity; now, therefore, be it
4	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Director of
5	Transportation to execute the agreement between the Federal Bureau of Investigations and
6	the City and County of San Francisco, enabling the Municipal Transportation Agency to
7	participate in the Federal Government's cooperative known as InfraGard, which allows for the
8	exchange of security information between the Federal Government and major transit
9	agencies.
