| 7  | WHEREAS, The California Code of Regulations Title 13, Division 2, Chapter 5, Article         |
| 8  | 1, Section 1103(e) and (f) requires all ambulances within the State to carry "a spare wheel  |
| 9  | with inflated tire" and "a jack and tools for wheel changes"; and,                           |
| 10 | WHEREAS, The California Vehicle Code Section 2512 requires the Commissioner of               |
| 11 | the California Highway Patrol to grant an exemption to the requirement upon request of the   |
| 12 | Board of Supervisors for non-commercial ambulances; and,                                     |
| 13 | WHEREAS, The San Francisco Fire Department operates non-commercia                            |
| 14 | ambulances; and,   |
| 15 | WHEREAS, The California Code of Regulations Section 1108(b) states that the                  |
| 16 | Commissioner will grant the exemption upon a request that contains the ambulance service     |
| 17 | name, the specific exemption requested, a finding from the county emergency medical care     |
| 18 | committee, and a finding from the Board of Supervisors that the exemption is necessary for   |
| 19 | public health and safety; and,   |
| 20 | WHEREAS, The Medical Director of the local Emergency Medical Services Section                |
| 21 | finds that the exemption is justified and has consented to the exemption; and,               |
| 22 | WHEREAS, Without such an exemption, San Francisco Fire Department's ambulances               |
| 23 | will be unable to carry sufficient equipment to appropriately respond to medical emergencies |
| 24 | in San Francisco; and,   |

| 1  | WHEREAS, The San Francisco Fire Department has 24-hour, seven days a week                    |

| 2  | emergency tire service available through the City's Central Shops; and,                      |
| 3  | WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco is 49 square miles, enabling quick             |
| 4  | response from the 24-hour repair service; now, therefore, be it                              |
| 5  | RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors finds that an exemption from Title 13,               |
| 6  | Division 2, Chapter 5, Article 1, Section 1103(e) and (f) is necessary for public health and |
| 7  | safety; and be it  |
| 8  | FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the San Francisco                 |
| 9  | Fire Department to be exempt from California Code of Regulations Title 13, Division 2,       |
| 10 | Chapter 5, Article 1, Section 1103(e) and (f), requiring ambulances to carry spare tire and  |
| 11 | jack; and, be it   |
| 12 | FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors shall send a letter requesting               |
| 13 | the exemption to the Commissioner of the California Highway Patrol.                          |
