RESOLUTION NO. 90-99

1 [FEDERAL FUNDING - COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT]
2 APPROVING THE 1999 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM. AUTHORIZING THE
3 MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO,
4 TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND THE CITY'S 1999 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK
5 GRANT (CDBG) ENTITLEMENT FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN
6 DEVELOPMENT, AND PROGRAM INCOME GENERATED BY MAYOR'S OFFICE OF
7 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, MAYOR'S OFFICE OF HOUSING AND THE SAN
8 FRANCISCO REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY UP TO \$65,941,040 WHICH INCLUDE INDIRECT
9 COSTS OF \$124,015; AND APPROVING EXPENDITURE SCHEDULES FOR RECIPIENT
10 DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES AND FOR INDIRECT COSTS, AND DETERMINING NO
11 ENVIRONMENTAL EVALUATION IS REQUIRED, AUTHORIZING THE RECEIPT AND
12 DEPOSIT IN UNRESERVED FUND BALANCES OF 1999 CDBG ENTITLEMENT FUNDS IN
13 EXCESS OF \$25,123,000; PLACING \$503,475 ON RESERVE.

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16 WHEREAS, Under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as
17 amended, and related Federal regulations, San Francisco is eligible to receive a Community
18 Development Block Grant; and

19 WHEREAS, The Mayor's Office of Community Development has prepared programs entitled
20 1999 Community Development Program Final Proposal, and the 1999 Community Development
21 Program Expenditure Schedules for an anticipated entitlement, and reprogrammed funds from prior
22 year Community Development Programs and program income generated by Mayor's Office of
23 Community Development, Mayor's Office of Housing and the San Francisco Redevelopment Agency
24 as needed, up to ^{\$65,941,040}~~\$65,853,985~~; and , be it

1 WHEREAS, The City will receive \$25,123,000 in 1998 CDBG Program funds; and

2 WHEREAS, A Preliminary Environmental Record on the Final Proposal has been prepared;
3 and

4 WHEREAS, The Certifying Officer shall follow procedural provisions of NEPA and CEQA to
5 make certain that all projects are in compliance with the applicable state and federal provisions and
6 requirements; now, therefore, be it

7 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby approve the 1999 Community
8 Development Program Final Proposal, to accept and expend the City's 1999 Community Development
9 Block Grant Entitlement from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, transfer and
10 expend reprogrammed funds from prior year Community Development Programs up to \$25,210,055
11 and an estimated \$40,730,985 in program income generated by the Mayor's Office of Community
12 Development, the Mayor's Office of Housing and the San Francisco Redevelopment Agency, and
13 authorizes the Mayor to enter into and execute contract agreements between the City and County of
14 San Francisco and departments identified in the 1999 Community Development Program; and, be it

15 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby authorize the Mayor to
16 enter into and execute a contract between the City and County of San Francisco and the San Francisco
17 Conservation Corps; be it

18 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City's Annual Salary Ordinance be amended to reflect the
19 staffing identified in the expenditure schedule; be it

20 FURTHER RESOLVED, That indirect costs of \$124,015 have been included in this grant;

21 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Mayor is hereby authorized to submit documentation and
22 certifications required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.
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1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That any program funds not authorized or approved for expenditure
2 by the Board of Supervisors shall either be reserved for future Board of Supervisors Finance
3 Committee approval, or shall be considered unreserved fund balances, the expenditure of which shall
4 require approval by the Board of Supervisors, and, be it

5 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Mayor is hereby authorized to receive and deposit in
6 unreserved fund balances any 1999 CDBG Entitlement Funds in excess funds would require the
7 approval of the Board of Supervisors; and, be it

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9 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors places \$503,475 on reserve until
10 budget details of specific proposals are submitted to be released by the Finance Committee.

Resolution approving the 1999 Community Development Program authorizing the Mayor, on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, to accept and expend the City's 1999 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) entitlement from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, and program income generated by Mayor's Office of Community Development, Mayor's Office of Housing and the San Francisco Redevelopment Agency up to \$65,941,040 which include indirect costs of \$124,015; approving expenditure schedules for recipient departments and agencies and for indirect costs, and, determining no environmental evaluation is required, authorizing the receipt and deposit in unreserved fund balances of 1999 CDBG entitlement funds in excess of \$25,123,000; placing \$503,475 on reserve.

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
