1 [SFLAFCo Future Work Plan] 2 3 Resolution requesting support of the Board of Supervisors for the Future Work 4 Plan of the San Francisco Local Agency Formation Commission. 5 6 WHEREAS, The primary purpose of the San Francisco Local Agency Formation 7 Commission (San Francisco LAFCo or Commission) under the Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg 8 Local Government Reorganization Act of 2000 is to review public service needs, 9 including utility service, and to determine whether new government entities should be 10 created or changes in existing governments should be made to address the needs of its 11 citizens; 12 WHEREAS, The Commission adopted by resolution its Energy Services Study and Recommendations for Electric Utility Service; 13 14 WHEREAS, The Study indicates that reliable, reasonably priced electric service 15 is vital to the City's economic health and public welfare; 16 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Local Agency Formation Commission has adopted on November 8, 2002 by the San Francisco Local Agency Formation 17 Commission's Resolution No. 02-03 a Future Work Plan that includes pursuing a 18 19 strategic plan for power supply, transmission, and distribution to the City and County of 20 San Francisco and other work plan items as follows: 21 22 1.
