[Open Government: Reinstating CityWatch Telecasts.]

Resolution to protect open government by re-instating cable programming for the Police and Planning Commissions on San Francisco Government Television, CityWatch.

WHEREAS, Ensuring that government is reaching its decisions in full view of the public is essential to a working democracy; and

WHEREAS, Such transparency and open government are essential to maintain the public trust; and

WHEREAS, Cable access San Francisco Government Television, CityWatch is one of the main conduits for San Francisco residents appreciate government discourse and track how policy decisions are made; and

WHEREAS, In January, the Mayor suspended the telecasting of General Fund commission hearings, including the Police Commission and Planning Commission, on CityWatch as part of his midyear spending reductions; and

WHEREAS, Given the sensitive and often controversial decisions made during Police
Department and Planning Department commission hearings, the Police and Planning
Departments are two of the most politically important City departments where open
government is most paramount; and

WHEREAS, There is great public interests in following the Police Commission and Planning Commission proceedings on CityWatch; and

WHEREAS, The Police and Planning Commissions offices have received numerous inquiries from residents concerned about the suspension of CityWatch telecasts and urging their reinstatement; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the immediate reinstatement of the telecasting of the Police Commission and Planning Commission; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the Mayor to exempt the telecasting of the Police Commission and Planning Commission from suspensions during future budget deliberations.
