

1 [Contract funds to update the single estimate of unmet need for HIV primary care in San  
2 Francisco, San Mateo, and Marin counties for the year 2002 and conduct subanalyses as  
3 required.]

4 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH) to**  
5 **enter retroactively into an agreement with the University of California, San Francisco**  
6 **(UCSF) the primary contractor, and expend funds in the amount of \$22,224 for**  
7 **estimates of unmet need for HIV primary care in the San Francisco Eligible**  
8 **Metropolitan Area (EMA); for the period of September 1, 2003 to February 29, 2004.**

10 WHEREAS, UCSF is the recipient of a grant award from the federal Health Resources  
11 and Services Administration (HRSA) for statistical analysis and subanalysis of estimates of  
12 unmet need for HIV primary care in the San Francisco EMA (San Francisco, San Mateo, and  
13 Marin Counties); and,

14 WHEREAS, UCSF, and SFDPH have agreed to enter into a subcontract agreement to  
15 participate in this project; and

16 WHEREAS, UCSF has agreed to reimburse SFDPH in the amount of \$22,224 from this  
17 award under the terms of this subcontract agreement; and,

18 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds, UCSF requires SFDPH to enter into  
19 an agreement (The "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of  
20 Supervisors in File No. \_\_\_\_\_, which is hereby declared to be a part of this  
21 resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

22 WHEREAS, The subcontract budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$2,381  
23 now, therefore, be it

24 **RESOLVED**, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to enter retroactively into a subcontract  
25 agreement in the amount of \$22,224 with UCSF, the primary contractor; and, be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the  
2 Agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the position funded  
4 under this agreement as a "G" or grant-funded position which would terminate when the  
5 agreement expires.
