Today, there are many families who travel across the city to use this particular park because their neighborhood parks lack the same amenities and upkeep, and are often not safe spaces for children.

As San Francisco struggles with growing economic inequality, I believe that it is of the utmost importance to have effective representation from communities of color and low-income communities who are often left out of important decision-making processes that impact them. I have experienced the difference between open space that is well-kept and prioritized over a park or recreation center that was overlooked, and not fully funded because that space served predominantly people of color and low-income communities. These communities are also typically made up of people working in service and trade jobs who are struggling to raise families and keep their heads above water in one of the most expensive cities in the world. Access to quality parks and open space should not be determined by these types economic barriers.

I currently hold a seat on the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission's Citizens Advisory Committee, and am fully aware of both the commitments and expectations required of an appointment to an advisory body. I am deeply involved with serving our Richmond District community through civic engagement. I am also currently a 2017 Cohort Fellow for Urban Habitat's Boards and Commissions Leadership Institute, where I am furthering my knowledge around issues of equity in land use, housing and transportation. More importantly, during my tenure as Chair of the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission's Citizens Advisory Committee, I have been committed to fighting for low-income communities of color to feel represented and heard. I have worked with our Community Benefits Department to fill vacant seats with candidates from diverse ethnic and economic backgrounds, as well as women, members of the LGBTQ community, and young people. I authored and led the passage of a number of resolutions, including a plan for truly affordable housing at the Balboa Reservoir, working with organizations, such as PODER and the Council of Community Housing Organizations to achieve 100% deeply affordable housing; and a resolution to renew and fulfill the SFPUC's environmental justice agreement with the Southeast Community, by building a new Community Facility Center that will help that community thrive, and acknowledging that we've failed them for the last three decades.

If appointed to PROSAC, I will continue to pursue policy and decision making with an equity lens so that all San Franciscans have access to parks and open spaces that meet the needs of their communities. I respectfully ask for your recommendation and look forward to potentially serving on this seat.

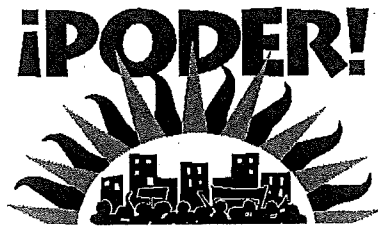

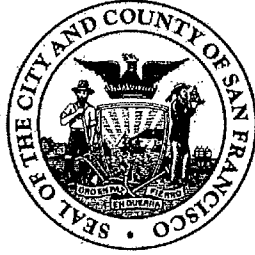



Vacant seat 13, succeeding Les Hilger, term expired, must be nominated by the District 1 Supervisor from the organizations listed in Resolution No. 391-13, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term ending February 1, 2018.

Seat 14, Richard Rothman, term expires February 1, 2017, must be nominated by the District 1 Supervisor and from District 1, for a two-year term ending February 1, 2019.

Seat 15, Kenneth Maley, term expires February 1, 2018, must be nominated by the District 3 Supervisor from the organizations listed in Resolution No. 391-13, for a two-year term.

Seat 16, Kim Hirschfield, term expires February 1, 2017, must be nominated by the District 3 Supervisor and from District 3, for a two-year term ending February 1, 2019.

Seat 17, Ana Teresa Gee, term expires February 1, 2018, must be nominated by the District 6 Supervisor from the organizations listed in Resolution No. 391-13, for a two-year term.

Seat 18, Jane Weil, term expires February 1, 2017, must be nominated by the District 6 Supervisor and from District 6, for a two-year term ending February 1, 2019.

Reports: Annually provide input on: 1) the Strategic Plan, which establishes or reaffirms the mission, goals and objectives for the Recreation and Park Department ("Department"); 2) the Capital Plan, for the development, renovation, replacement, and maintenance of capital assets, and the acquisition of real property; and 3) the Operational Plan, which details proposed improvements to the Department's services and responsiveness to customer needs.
