I am writing to express interest in Seat 13 of the Parks Recreation and Open Space Committee (PROSAC), which is currently vacant.

As a person of color, who grew up low-income and blue collar, my family lived in apartments and townhouses with little to no access to family-friendly open space. We were fortunate enough to have access to a neighborhood park which was a welcoming space with a number of amenities. Today, there are many families who travel across the city to use this particular park because their neighborhood parks lack the same amenities and upkeep, and are often not safe spaces for children.

As San Francisco struggles with growing economic inequality, I believe that it is of the utmost importance to have effective representation from communities of color and low-income communities who are often left out of important decision-making processes that impact them. I have experienced the difference between open space that is well-kept and prioritized over a park or recreation center that was overlooked, and not fully funded because that space served predominantly people of color and low-income communities. These communities are also typically made up of people working in service and trade jobs who are struggling to raise families and keep their heads above water in one of the most expensive cities in the world. Access to quality parks and open space should not be determined by these types economic barriers.

I currently hold a seat on the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission's Citizens Advisory Committee, and am fully aware of both the commitments and expectations required of an appointment to an advisory body. I am deeply involved with serving our Richmond District community through civic engagement. I am also currently a 2017 Cohort Fellow for Urban Habitat's Boards and Commissions Leadership Institute, where I am furthering my knowledge around issues of equity in land use, housing and transportation. More importantly, during my tenure as Chair of the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission's Citizens Advisory Committee, I have been committed to fighting for low-income communities of color to feel represented and heard. I have worked with our Community Benefits Department to fill vacant seats with candidates from diverse ethnic and economic backgrounds, as well as women, members of the LGBTQ community, and young people. I authored and led the passage of a number of resolutions, including a plan for truly affordable housing at the Balboa Reservoir, working with organizations, such as PODER and the Council of Community Housing Organizations to achieve 100% deeply affordable housing; and a resolution to renew and fulfill the SFPUC's environmental justice agreement with the Southeast Community, by building a new Community Facility Center that will help that community thrive, and acknowledging that we've failed them for the last three decades.

If appointed to PROSAC, I will continue to pursue policy and decision making with an equity lens so that all San Franciscans have access to parks and open spaces that meet the needs of their communities. I respectfully ask for your recommendation and look forward to potentially serving on this seat.

Four (4) of the members chosen from the list maintained by the Commission shall be individuals nominated by an environmental organization. In addition, one (1) member shall be appointed by the Mayor.

If the system of district elections set forth in Charter, Section 13.110, is discontinued, each Supervisor shall appoint one (1) member of the Committee from the list maintained by the Commission and one (1) member without restriction.

The Committee members shall serve for two-year terms at the will of the appointing authority, except that at the first meeting of the Committee, the General Manager of the Recreation and Park Department shall, by lot, designate twelve (12) members to serve terms of one (1) year. Thereafter, all members shall be appointed to two-year terms and no member shall serve more than four (4) consecutive terms.
