# Why CCSF Needs AI Training

- Currently no AI training in the City's learning catalog
- 2,000+ employees in ChatGPT pilot; first training had 700+ attendees
- AI inventory (Ordinance #288-24) will likely identify more AI tools in use by departments
- We don't have the capacity to create our own training:
  - DT's Emerging Technology division has only 1 of 3 FTEs currently filled
  - AI Working Group expended considerable resources to create a six-minute video

# How and Why We Selected InnovateUS

The City's AI Working Group reviewed available AI trainings and selected InnovateUS based on the following factors:

- Public-sector-focused training
- Technology-agnostic (no bias toward specific AI models)
- Vetted by peer governments (CA, OR, MD, Boston, Miami-Dade)
- Self-paced, two-hour courses for flexibility
- Training files can be hosted on our internal platform
- Covers risks: privacy, bias, misinformation, deepfakes

# Training Modules Offered

1. **Responsible AI for Public Professionals** – Understanding AI basics, risks, and best practices
2. **Scaling AI in Your Organization** – Evaluating how to apply AI to projects and manage risk
3. **Fast Field Scanning with AI** – Identifying, evaluating, and adapting evidence-based policy solutions from other jurisdictions

# MOU Key Terms and Safeguards

- **Legal Protections:** InnovateUS indemnifies the City from any legal claims
- **Minimal Data Sharing:** No City data is shared except aggregated training completion data
- **Optional Employee Feedback:** Anonymous voluntary surveys
- **Transparency:** Confirms applicability of CA Public Records Act & Sunshine Ordinance, provides BOS opportunity to review
- **Public Communications Oversight:** City approval required for any external messaging from InnovateUS related to San Francisco
