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3 **Ordinance authorizing settlement of the lawsuit filed by Judy O'Neil against the City**
4 **and County of San Francisco for \$2,500,000; the lawsuit was filed on**
5 **December 19, 2017, in U.S. District Court for the Northern District of California, Case**
6 **No. 17-cv-07190; entitled Judy O'Neil v. City and County of San Francisco, et al.; the**
7 **lawsuit involves an officer involved shooting that resulted in the death of Keita O'Neil.**

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9 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

10 Section 1. Pursuant to Charter Section 6.102(5), the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes
11 the City Attorney to settle the action entitled Judy O'Neil v. City and County of San Francisco,
12 et al., U.S. District Court for the Northern District of California, Case No. 17-cv-07190 by the
13 payment of \$2,500,000. The lawsuit involves an officer involved shooting that resulted in the
14 death of Keita O'Neil.

15 Section 2. The above-named action was filed in Northern District of California of
16 United States District Court on December 19, 2017, and the following parties were named in
17 the lawsuit: Plaintiff and successor-in-interest to Decedent Keita O'Neil, Judy O'Neil;
18 Guardian Ad Litem, April Green; Defendants City and County of San Francisco, Christopher
19 Samayoa, and Edric Talusan.
