Resolution declaring October 23, 2003 “San Francisco City Guides Day” in San Francisco.

WHEREAS, The City Guides volunteers have provided historical walking tours of the City of San Francisco since 1978; and

WHEREAS, City Guides tours celebrate the culture, diversity, lore and legends relating to the City’s rich heritage; and

WHEREAS, City Guides tours have been enjoyed by more than a quarter-million people in the 25 years of its presence; and

WHEREAS, City Guides tours are one of the last free services offered to San Francisco’s visitors and residents; and

WHEREAS, City Guides have served as San Francisco’s official guides since their inception-appointment by then-Mayor Dianne Feinstein at the time of the 1984 Democratic Convention; and

WHEREAS, The current corps of 220 City Guides gives more than 5,000 volunteer hours each year to promote San Francisco to its visitors and residents; and therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco recognizes City Guide’s contribution of 25 years of valuable service; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby declares October 23, 2003 “San Francisco City Guides Day” in San Francisco.
