AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE PORT OF SAN FRANCISCO TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND \$600,000 IN STATE FUNDS FROM THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND \$50,000 FROM THE METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION TO SUPPORT THE WATER TRANSIT BLUE RIBBON ADVISORY TASK FORCE AND FOREGOING REIMBURSEMENT OF INDIRECT COSTS; AND AUTHORIZING THE PORT OF SAN FRANCISCO TO HOLD THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA HARMLESS AS REQUIRED IN THE FUND TRANSFER AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, In Senate Resolution No. 19 of the 1997-98 Regular Session, the California Legislature created a Blue Ribbon Task Force for Bay Area Water Transit to study increasing regional mobility through expanded water transit on San Francisco Bay; and,

WHEREAS, The Bay Area Council, a non-profit regional policy group, was given the actual responsibility for organizing the Blue Ribbon Task Force, administering a study and producing an implementation plan; and,

WHEREAS, The California Legislature appropriated \$600,000 to the Port of San Francisco in the California Budget Act of 1998, Chapter 324, Item 2660-101-001 to match local funds to support the Water Transit Blue Ribbon Advisory Task Force's work; and,

WHEREAS, The Metropolitan Transportation Commission awarded the Port of San Francisco and the Port of Oakland \$50,000 from the Five Percent Reserve Bridge Toll Program to complete the study; and,

WHEREAS, In Resolution No. 98-101, the San Francisco Port Commission authorized the Port to accept the grant funds in the amount of \$600,000 from the California Department of Transportation and \$50,000 from MTC for work related to the Blue Ribbon Task Force for Bay Area Water Transit pending approval of the Board of Supervisors, a copy of Resolution 98-101 is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 982054; and,

WHEREAS, The California Department of Transportation Commission is requiring a substantial match of local funds and \$175,000 has been committed from several local funding sources, including the Metropolitan Transportation Commission's \$50,000 grant; and,

WHEREAS, The California Department of Transportation and the Metropolitan Transportation Commission do not allow for reimbursement of indirect costs; and,

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Commission authorized the Executive Director in Resolution No. 98-101 to enter into a contract with the Bay Area Council in the amount of \$650,000 for the purposes of performing services funded by both grants; and,

WHEREAS, The State of California's Fund Transfer Agreement includes a clause requiring the Port to hold harmless the State of California as provided below:

"The San Francisco Port Commission hereby indemnifies, hold harmless and defends the State of California, its officers and employees from any claim, cause of action, loss or damage arising directly or indirectly from the transfer of the BUDGET ITEM funds to the San Francisco Port Commission, and/or from the representations made under paragraph 2, and/or from any allegation of failure to properly discharge any obligation under paragraph 3 of this agreement." now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, The Executive Director of the Port of San Francisco is authorized to accept and expend \$600,000 from the California Department of Transportation and \$50,000 from the Metropolitan Transportation Commission for the purpose of conducting work related to the Blue Ribbon Task Force for Bay Area Water Transit; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, The San Francisco Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Port of San Francisco to hold the State of California Harmless from all claims arising out of or connected with the work performed by the Port of San Francisco pursuant to the terms of the Fund Transfer Agreement, and to execute all necessary documents relating to these grants.
