2 **PROCLAIMING OCTOBER 15 THROUGH OCTOBER 21, 2000 AS CALIFORNIA RETIRED**
3 **TEACHERS' WEEK IN THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO.**

4 WHEREAS, The California Retired Teacher's Association was formed by Laura E.
5 Settle 71 years ago during the Great Depression; and

6 WHEREAS, Laura Settle's goal in forming the association was to provide relief to the
7 economic hardships confronting retired teachers; and

8 WHEREAS, The California Retired Teacher's Association has since become a leading
9 advocate for providing teachers with sufficient retirement income; and

10 WHEREAS, The California Retired Teacher's Association also provides continuing
11 support to active and future teachers, including scholarships exceeding \$350,000 annually;
12 and

13 WHEREAS, The California Retired Teacher's Association share a commitment to
14 improve their communities through volunteer activities; and

15 WHEREAS, Retired teachers continue to give freely of their own time to support a wide
16 range of charitable and community activities, including volunteer tutoring, participation in
17 Gateway reading and Head Start Programs, serve as hospital and hospice aides, provide
18 transportation for the blind, collect food and clothing for the needy, caring for children of
19 pregnant teen-agers so that the parent may complete their schooling and many other
20 activities; and

21 WHEREAS, The volunteer time provided by retired teachers is estimated to exceed \$20
22 million annually; and

23 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco recognize the vital contributions of
24 California's retired teachers and honor their ongoing commitment of the California Retired
25 Teacher's Association to all teachers; now therefore be it
