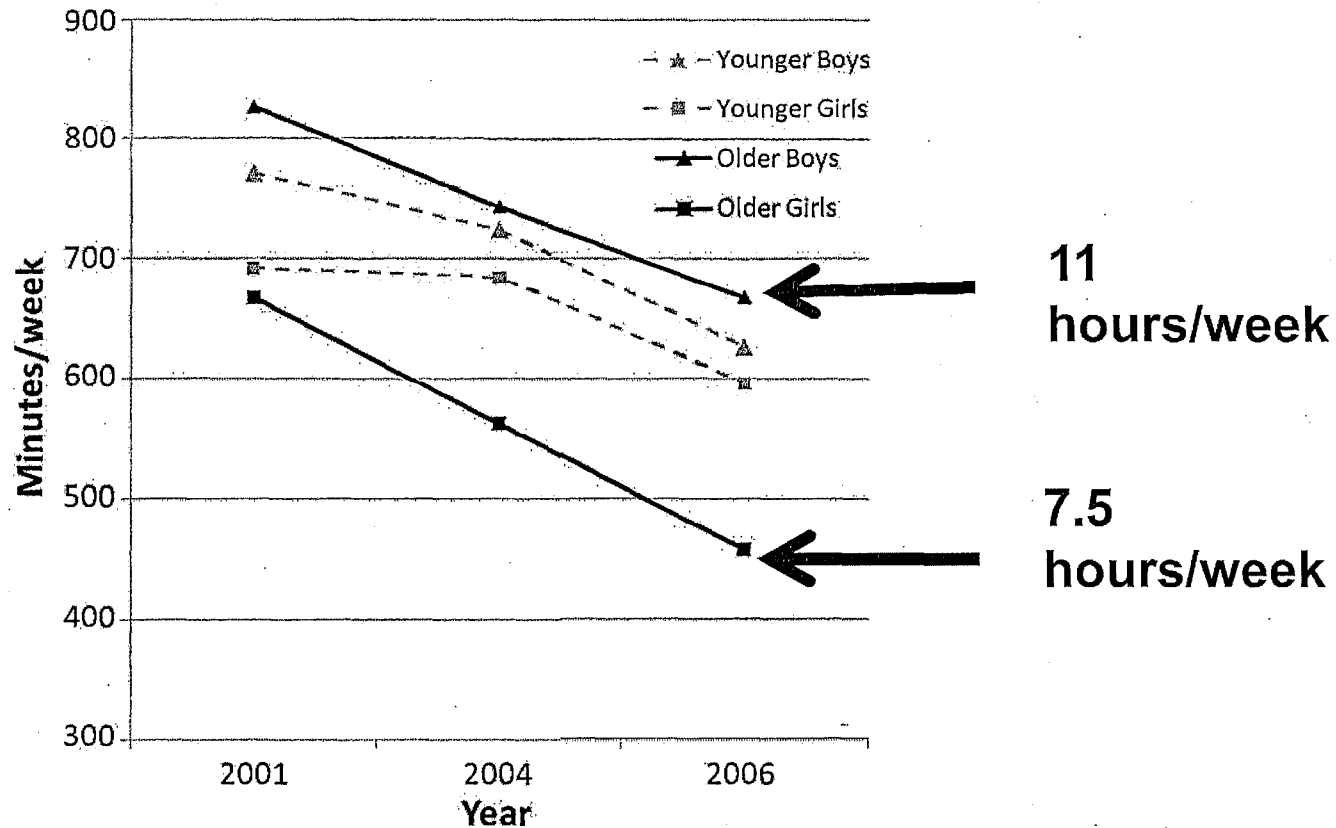

# 2. Outdoor time decreasing

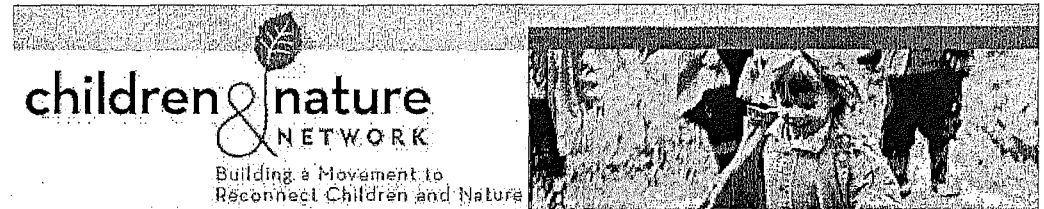
Children's average time spent outdoors (minutes/week) over 5 years, by sex and age cohort.
