6	WHEREAS, As the chief accounting officer and auditor for the City and County of San
7 8	Francisco, the Controller is responsible for the financial systems, procedures, internal controls
	and reports on the City's fiscal condition; and,
9	WHEREAS, The Controller also conducts financial and performance audits of
10 11	departments, agencies, concessions and contracts; and,
	WHEREAS, In addition, the Controller provides a variety of support services that
12 13	include processing the City budget, maintaining the City financial accounting information
	system and preparing paychecks for all employees; and,
14	WHEREAS, The Controller's above contribution to the City and County of San
15	Francisco is invaluable and essential to the efficient management and performance of the
16	City; and,
17	WHEREAS, In order to ensure that the entity providing advice and counsel to other
18	City departments about efficient management and performance (the Controller) is itself
19	managed efficiently and performs efficiently, it is necessary for the independent Budget
20	Analyst to the Board of Supervisors to conduct a management audit of the Controller's Office;
21	and,
22	WHEREAS, Supervisors McGoldrick and Daly have previously introduced Charter
23 24	Amendments calling for the creation of Auditor General and Public Advocate positions,

Supervisors Tony Hall, Matt Gonzalez, Tom Ammiano, Bevan Dufty, Sophie Maxwell, Jake McGoldrick, and Gerardo Sandoval

1	respectively, which exhibited a desire to expand and strengthen current City financial controls
2	and City auditing practices, many of which already reside within the Controller's domain; and,
3	WHEREAS, A Charter Amendment significantly expanding the powers of the
4	Controller, as well as dramatically increasing the budget of the Controller's Office, will be
5	circulated for signatures in an attempt to place the Charter Amendment on the November
6	ballot; and,
7	WHEREAS, Before changes are made to the current powers and current budget of the
8	Controller's Office, the people of the City and County of San Francisco should be assured
9	that the Controller's Office is already managed efficiently and performs efficiently; now,
10	therefore, be it
11	MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors directs the Budget Analyst to conduct a
12	management audit of the Controller's Office; and, be it
13	FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby amends the Schedule of
14	Management Audits and directs the Budget Analyst to conduct a management audit of the
15	Controller's Office on a priority basis as the next management audit assignment.
