

1 [Drug court partnership program for non-violent drug offenders.]

3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH) to**
4 **accept retroactively and expend a grant in the amount of \$425,175 from the California**
5 **Department of Health Services (CDHS) to provide drug court partnership funds and to**
6 **enter into an agreement for the use of these funds; for the period of July 1, 2003, to**
7 **June 30, 2004.**

9 WHEREAS, SFDPH has applied for and been awarded a grant from CDHS in the
10 amount of \$425,175 to provide drug court partnership funds; and,

11 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, CDHS requires the City to
12 enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the
13 Board of Supervisors in File No. _____, which is hereby declared to be a part of
14 this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

15 WHEREAS, This Resolution requires expedited review by the Board of Supervisors
16 because the grant award letter was not received until after the grant start date; and,

17 WHEREAS, Resolutions authorizing the acceptance and expenditure of grant funds
18 may be placed automatically on consent agendas in committee, as they are usually
19 considered to be routine items, and this resolution authorizes the acceptance and expenditure
20 of grant funding; and,

21 WHEREAS, The Department proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on
22 program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

23 RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend retroactively a
24 grant in the amount of \$425,175 from CDHS; and, be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of
2 indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend the
4 grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Agreement, pursuant to San
5 Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and, be it

6 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
7 agreement on behalf of the City.
