DECLARING JUNE 19, 1999 CLEAN POWER DAY IN SAN FRANCISCO

WHEREAS, On Saturday, June 19,<sup>th</sup> the 1999 Clean Power Day Celebration will be held in Golden Gate Park and will be an all day fair that will educate Northern Californians about their choices as consumers of energy and the benefits of using clean renewable energy, electric vehicles and energy efficient technologies; and,

WHEREAS, According to the Natural Resources Defense Council (NRDC), electricity generation is the nation's biggest source of air pollutants, producing 2/3 of sulfur dioxides, 1/3 of nitrogen oxides and 1/3 of carbon dioxides found in the air; and,

WHEREAS, In 1998 California fully deregulated the sale of electricity, becoming the first state to give residents and businesses an option in choosing an electricity provider; and,

WHEREAS, California still generates the majority of its electricity from non-renewable resources, such as coal, fossil, and nuclear generation; and,

WHEREAS, Demand for electricity from renewable sources has grown but still remains a small part of the nation's energy supply, with renewable sources other then hydroelectric accounting for only 2 percent of the nation's energy consumption according to the NRDC; and,

WHEREAS, California is the bellweather state in the field of technology innovation and clean energy markets and must continue this tradition to protect California's environment and public health; and,

WHEREAS, The Clean Power Day 1999 Celebration will educate consumers about their options and will provide demonstrations of clean energy technologies such as wind, solar, photovoltaic panels, fuel cells and electric and hybrid cars and buses; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco declares June 19, 1999 Clean Power Day and encourages residents to participate and learn about the important decisions they make as consumers of energy.
