WHEREAS, DPH applied for and was awarded two grants (Assistant Public Health Lab Director Position and the Public Health Laboratory Equipment and Supplies) for a total of \$300,655 from the California Department of Health Services (CDHS), Division of Communicable Disease Control to support the Public Health Laboratory Director Training Program, for the period of April 1, 2007, through March 31, 2009; and,

WHEREAS, These grants allow for the training of a public health laboratory director (\$230,800) and allow for the materials and supplies (\$69,855) involved in such training; and,

WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, CDHS requires the City to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 070626 ; which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and.

WHEREAS, The grant budget does not include a provision for indirect costs in order to maximize use of grant funds on direct services; and,

WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment and reimburses the department for an existing Chief Microbiologist position (Job Class 2466) at 1.00 FTE from April 1, 2007 through March 31, 2009; now, therefore, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the position funded under this agreement as a "G" or grant-funded position which would terminate when the agreement expires.
