

1 [U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Community Development Block Grant,  
2 Emergency Shelter Grant, and HOME Investment Partnerships Grant Application for 2011-  
3 2012]

4 **Resolution authorizing the Mayor, on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco, to**  
5 **apply for the 2011-2012 entitlement allocations for the Community Development Block**  
6 **Grant, Emergency Shelter Grant, and HOME Investment Partnerships Program from the**  
7 **U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.**

9 WHEREAS, The Mayor and the Mayor’s Office of Housing annually applies on behalf of  
10 the City for entitlement funding for CDBG, ESG, and HOME programs through HUD; and

11 WHEREAS, The Citizen Participation Plan for these programs requires Board of  
12 Supervisors’ authorization for submission of the required applications; and

13 WHEREAS, In previous years the Board has authorized submission of these applications  
14 via an “Apply For-Accept-Expend” Resolution;

15 WHEREAS, The lack of a finalized 2010-2011 Federal budget has significantly delayed  
16 the release of 2011-2012 entitlement amounts for all HUD programs, including CDBG, ESG,  
17 and HOME; and

18 WHEREAS, HUD has not extended the application deadline for these programs,  
19 although it has not released the entitlement amounts for these programs; and

20 WHEREAS, The Mayor’s Office of Housing will bring an Accept and Expend Resolution  
21 before the Board of Supervisors within 45 days of the release of 2011-2012 entitlement  
22 amounts, now, therefore, be it

23 RESOLVED, That the Mayor of the City and County of San Francisco is hereby  
24 authorized, on behalf of the City, to submit all necessary documentation to apply for  
25 entitlement funding for the CDBG, ESG, and HOME programs, in accordance with the

1 purposes and goals for the funding as generally set forth in the 2010-14 Five-Year  
2 Consolidated Plan.
