3 **Resolution authorizing adoption of the San Francisco County Plan for the Substance**  
4 **Abuse and Crime Prevention Act of 2000 for Fiscal Year 2002-2003.**

6 WHEREAS, The voters of the State of California passed Proposition 36: The  
7 Substance Abuse and Crime Prevention Act of 2000; and,

8 WHEREAS, Proposition 36 requires certain non-violent drug possession offenders to  
9 receive substance abuse treatment in the community rather than be incarcerated; and,

10 WHEREAS, Proposition 36 services began on July 1, 2001; and,

11 WHEREAS, The County is required to adopt a County Plan for the Substance Abuse  
12 and Crime Prevention Act of 2000, Fiscal Year 2002-03; and,

13 WHEREAS, The County Plan proposed by the San Francisco Department of Public  
14 Health is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. \_\_\_\_\_, which is  
15 hereby declared to be a part of the Resolution as if set forth fully herein; now, therefore, be it

16 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the San Francisco  
17 County Plan for the Substance Abuse and Crime Prevention Act of 2000 for Fiscal Year 2002-  
18 03; and, be it

19 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors assures the County of San  
20 Francisco shall comply with the provisions of the Substance Abuse and Crime Prevention Act  
21 of 2000 and the California Code of Regulations, Division 4, Chapter 2.5.
