On August 15, 2018, the Historic Preservation Commission (HPC) adopted Resolution No. 969 to initiate Article 10 landmark designation of 449 14th Street, known as the former Welsh Presbyterian Church. Under Article 10, initiation and recommendation are two distinct steps of the landmark designation process which require separate hearings and resolutions.

Attached is a draft **Resolution to Recommend** approval to the Board of Supervisors the designation of the former Welsh Presbyterian Church as a San Francisco landmark under Article 10 of the Planning Code, Section 1004.1. The Planning Department recommends adopting this Resolution.
