RESOLVED, That in accordance with Section 23958.4 of the California Business and Professions Code, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby determines for the foregoing reasons that the issuance of a Type 42 on-sale beer and wine public premises license to Jeff Campbell, for Whole Foods Market, in addition to its existing Type 20 off-sale beer and wine alcoholic beverage control license, located at 1765 California Street (District 2), will serve the public

convenience and necessity of the people of the City and County of San Francisco; and be it, FURTHER RESOLVED, That the following conditions are imposed: 1) The petitioner(s) shall provide off-street parking spaces for no less than 90 vehicles for use by patrons of the premises. 2) There shall be no deliveries accepted between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. or between the hours of 3:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. each day of the week. 3) Valet parking shall be provided during all hours of operation each day of the week. 4) A camera on the California Street loading dock door shall be maintained for the purposes of controlling the yellow zones and preventing double parking of delivery vehicles.
