2 AMENDING THE RULES OF ORDER OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE CITY
3 AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO BY AMENDING RULE 2.28.1 TO REQUIRE THAT A
4 PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT BE INTRODUCED BY A SUPERVISOR AT A
5 REGULAR BOARD MEETING HELD NOT LESS THAN 169 DAYS PRIOR TO THE
6 ELECTION, RATHER THAN THE CURRENT REQUIREMENT OF 168 DAYS PRIOR TO
7 THE ELECTION.

11 MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
12 hereby amends Rule 2.28.1 of the Rules of Order of the Board, to read as follows:

13 **6.28.1 INTRODUCTION; REFERRAL TO COMMITTEE; COMMITTEE REPORT.** A
14 proposed Charter amendment shall be introduced by a Supervisor at a regular Board meeting
15 held not less than ((168)) 169 days prior to the election at which it is to be acted upon by the
16 electors. At that time, the sponsor shall submit complete text. The introduction of a "skeletal"
17 Charter amendment shall not satisfy the requirements of this ((section)) Rule. Upon
18 introduction, the proposed Charter amendment shall be referred to the appropriate Board
19 committee for public hearing.


