4 **Resolution authorizing the Recreation and Park Department to accept and expend a**
5 **grant in the amount of \$250,000 from the California State Coastal Conservancy for**
6 **habitat restoration and trail improvements in Glen Canyon Park.**

8 WHEREAS, Glen Canyon Park is a designated significant natural resource area that
9 supports locally important plant animal habitats; and

10 WHEREAS, The ecological health and recreational opportunities in the Glen Canyon
11 Natural Area are threatened by the expansion of invasive noxious weeds and erosion; and

12 WHEREAS, The Recreation and Park Department requires additional funds to make
13 improvements to the natural area; and

14 WHEREAS, The California State Legislature has established the State Coastal
15 Conservancy and authorized it to award grants to nine Bay Area Counties to improve public
16 access, restore natural habitats and promote educational and recreational opportunities in
17 urban areas; and

18 WHEREAS, The grants are awarded pursuant to guidelines established by the
19 California Coastal Conservancy for determination of project eligibility for funds; and

20 WHEREAS, The procedures established by the California Coastal Conservancy
21 require the applicant to certify by resolution approval of the application prior to submission to
22 the State; and

23 WHEREAS, The Recreation and Park Department proposed to maximize use of
24 available grant funds on program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant
25 budget; and

1 WHEREAS, matching funds in the amount of \$250,000 are required pursuant to this
2 grant. Thus total project costs for the Glen Canyon Park Project are \$500,000; now,
3 therefore, be it

4 RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors does hereby: 1) approve
5 the acceptance and expenditure of funding under the State Coastal Conservancy's San
6 Francisco Bay Program, 2) hereby approve the allocation of capital funds from the
7 Neighborhood Park Bond to provide required matching funds, 3) waives inclusion of indirect
8 costs in the grant budget and 4) authorizes the Recreation and Park Department to negotiate
9 and execute all agreements necessary to comply with the California Coastal Conservancy's
10 requirements.
