

1 [Funds to support HIV vaccine research.]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) to accept**  
4 **and expend retroactively a grant in the amount of \$139,432 from the Public Health**  
5 **Foundation Enterprises (PHFE); for the period of January 1, 2008 through December**  
6 **31, 2008.**

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8 WHEREAS, PHFE is the recipient of a grant award from the National Institute of Allergy  
9 and Infectious Disease (NIAID) to support HIV vaccine research; and,

10 WHEREAS, Through this grant, PHFE has agreed to fund DPH in the amount of  
11 \$139,432 to support the San Francisco HIV Vaccine and Prevention Unit (SFVPU) for the  
12 period of January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2008; and,

13 WHEREAS, These funds will allow the SFVPU to be part of an international network of  
14 sites to test promising HIV vaccine candidates and non-vaccine prevention strategies; and,

15 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, PHFE requires the City to  
16 enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the  
17 Board of Supervisors in File No. 080561; which is hereby declared to be a part of this  
18 resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

19 WHEREAS, An ASO amendment is not required as the grant partially reimburses DPH  
20 for four existing positions, Chief Medical Director (Job Class #2237) at .15 FTE, Senior  
21 Physician Specialist (Job Class #2232) at .10 FTE, Physician Assistant (Job Class #2218) at  
22 .50 FTE, Clerk Typist (Job Class #1424) at .25 FTE for the period of January 1, 2008 through  
23 December 31, 2008; and,

24 WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because DPH did not  
25 receive the agreement from PHFE until March 19, 2008; and,

1 WHEREAS, The budget includes a provision for indirect costs of \$24,110; now  
2 therefore, be it

3 RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend a grant in the  
4 amount of \$139,432 with PHFE; and, be it

5 FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and  
6 expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and,  
7 be it

8 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the  
9 agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

10 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate all positions  
11 funded under this agreement as "G" or grant-funded positions which would terminate when  
12 the agreement expires.
