WHEREAS, UCSF is the recipient of a grant award from the DHHS National Institutes of Health (NIH) for the conduct of a program entitled "A Randomized Trial of HIV Prevention in Harare Beerhalls"; and,

WHEREAS, It is considered in the best interests of NIH, UCSF, and SFDPH, AIDS to participate in this project; and,

WHEREAS, UCSF has agreed to reimburse SFDP, AIDS in the amount of \$39,774 under the terms of the second year of this agreement; and,

WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds UCSF requires SFDPH, AIDS to enter into a subcontract (The "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No.\_\_\_\_\_, which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

WHEREAS, The subcontract budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$4,262; and,

WHEREAS, This Resolution requires expedited review by the Board of Supervisors because the Department did not receive the UCSF subcontract until May 15, 2003, after the start date of this subcontract; and,

6	second year of a subcontract agreement with UCSF, the primary contractor, and to accept		
7	and expend funds in the amount of \$39,774 for services under "A Randomized Trial of HIV		
8	Prevention in Harare Beerhalls"; and, be it		
9	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the		
10	agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it		
11	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the position funded		
12	under this agreement as a "G" or grant-funded position which would terminate when the		
13	agreement expires.
