

1 [Accept and Expend Grant – Juvenile Accountability Block Grant.]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the Mayor’s Office of Community Investment (MOCI) to accept**  
4 **and expend a grant in the amount of \$200,000 from the State Corrections Standards**  
5 **Authority for the purpose of strengthening existing local juvenile justice accountability**  
6 **measures through the Juvenile Accountability Block Grant.**

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8 WHEREAS, MOCI desires to receive and utilize federal grant funds available through  
9 the Juvenile Accountability Block Grants (JABG) Program administered by the Corrections  
10 Standards Authority (CSA); and

11 WHEREAS, MOCI in partnership with DCYF/CRN’s will leverage existing intensive  
12 case management of high-risk juvenile offenders in hotspot neighborhoods through securing  
13 JABG funds for greatly needed vehicles for safe transportation and highly structured youth  
14 leadership and team building retreats, now, therefore, be it

15 RESOLVED that the Director of MOCI is authorized on behalf of the Board of  
16 Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco to submit the JABG application and sign  
17 the Grant Agreement with CSA, including any amendments thereof; and, be it

18 FURTHER RESOLVED that the City and County of San Francisco agrees to provide all  
19 matching funds required for said project, a 10% match will be provided DCYF from existing  
20 CRN intensive case management funds; and abide by the statutes and regulations governing  
21 the JABG Program as well as the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement as set forth by  
22 CSA; and, be it

23 FURTHER RESOLVED that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to  
24 supplant expenditures controlled by this body; and, be it

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1           FURTHER RESOLVED that grant funds received will be encumbered by June 30, 2009  
2 and liquidated by September 29, 2009, and no requests for extension will be submitted, and  
3           WHEREAS, The grant does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance amendment; and,  
4           WHEREAS, The grant permits indirect costs at 5% of total grant costs, be it  
5           FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City and County of San Francisco will include in the  
6 budget indirect costs at 5% of total grant costs.
