

1 [Accept and Expend Grant - Petroleum Products Compliances and Weighmaster Enforcement
2 Program - \$8,250]

4 **Resolution authorizing the Department of Public Health to accept and expend a grant**
5 **(Agreements #11-0036-SA) in the amount of \$8,250 from the California Department of**
6 **Food and Agriculture to fund the program entitled “Petroleum Products Compliances**
7 **and Weighmaster Enforcement Program” for the period of July 1, 2011, through June**
8 **30, 2012, and waiving indirect costs.**

10 WHEREAS, California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) has agreed to fund
11 DPH in the amount of \$8,250 for the period of July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012; and,

12 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, CDFA requires the City to
13 enter into an agreement (the “Agreement”), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the
14 Board of Supervisors in File No.110608; which is hereby declared to be a part of this
15 resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

16 WHEREAS, An ASO amendment is not required as the grant partially reimburses DPH
17 for two existing positions, two Inspector of Weights and Measures (Job Class #6220) at 0.10
18 FTE, for the period of July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012; and,

19 WHEREAS, Petroleum Products Compliances & Weighmaster Enforcement Program
20 grant does not contain indirect costs because the CDFA prohibits including indirect costs in
21 the budget; now, therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend a grant in the
23 amount of \$8,250 from the California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA); and, be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend the
25 grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and, be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of
2 indirect costs; and, be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
4 agreement on behalf of the City.
