6 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San
7 Francisco does hereby appoint hereinafter designated person(s) to serve as member(s)
8 of the Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer and Questioning Youth Task Force,
9 pursuant to Board of Supervisors Ordinance No. 166-98, for the terms specified:

11 Roy Butler, succeeding Michelle Tactay, (Seat No. 12/voting member),
12 unexpired portion of one year term ending June 30, 1999;

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the
2 following findings:

- 3 1. The membership of the Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender,
4 Queer and Questioning Youth Task Force has a goal to be
5 representative of the diversity of the City and County of San
6 Francisco.
- 7 2. Applicant Roy Butler, a new appointee, who is not a resident
8 of San Francisco, is a person with experience that uniquely
9 qualifies him to serve on the Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual,
10 Transgender, Queer and Questioning Youth Task Force.
- 11 3. The Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer and
12 Questioning Youth Task Force has attempted to fill the
13 position, for which Roy Butler was nominated, with an
14 individual who is a City resident and who has the specific
15 experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable
16 to do so at this time. The Rules Committee has certified
17 that Roy Butler is qualified to serve on the Lesbian, Gay,
18 Bisexual, Transgender, Queer and Questioning Youth Task
19 Force.
- 20 4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors
21 concludes that there is no other possible representative, who
22 is a resident of San Francisco and who has the specific
23 experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this
24 applicant, and who is willing to serve on the Lesbian, Gay,

1 Bisexual, Transgender, Queer and Questioning Youth Task Force
2 at this time; and, be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the
4 residency requirement for Roy Butler, as allowed in cases where no
5 qualified City resident, willing to serve, can be found, pursuant to
6 Section 4.101 of the City Charter that requires person(s) appointed
7 to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by
8 legislative act of the Board of Supervisors to be resident(s) of the
9 City and County of San Francisco.




