

1 [Accept and Expend Grant - Justice Reinvestment Initiative - \$100,000]

3 **Resolution authorizing the Adult Probation Department as lead staff to the Reentry**  
4 **Council of San Francisco to accept and expend a technical assistance grant with a**  
5 **cash value of \$100,000 from the United States Department of Justice, awarded to the**  
6 **Reentry Council, for activities related to the Justice Reinvestment Initiative.**

8 WHEREAS, The purpose of the Reentry Council of the City & County of San Francisco  
9 is to coordinate local efforts to support adults exiting local, state, and federal institutions; and

10 WHEREAS, The Reentry Council includes members from local, state, and federal  
11 criminal justice agencies, the City's human services and health agencies, and seven formerly  
12 incarcerated members; and

13 WHEREAS, The Reentry Council provides recommendations to the Board of  
14 Supervisors and the Mayor of San Francisco; and

15 WHEREAS, The purpose of justice reinvestment is to manage and allocate criminal  
16 justice populations more cost-effectively, generating savings that can be reinvested in  
17 evidence-based strategies that increase public safety while holding offenders accountable;  
18 and

19 WHEREAS, The City would benefit from a comprehensive examination of its criminal  
20 justice expenditures in order to identify opportunities for justice reinvestment; and

21 WHEREAS, Reentry Council of San Francisco has been selected to receive a  
22 technical assistance grant with a cash value of \$100,000 from the United States Department  
23 of Justice for the purposes of engaging in justice reinvestment activities; and

24 WHEREAS, That no actual funds are associated with this award; and

25 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment; and

1 WHEREAS, The Department proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on  
2 program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be

3 RESOLVED, That the Adult Probation Department as lead staff to the Reentry Council  
4 of the City and County of San Francisco is authorized to accept the grant described in the  
5 award letter on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. \_\_\_\_\_, which is  
6 hereby declared to be part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and

7 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of  
8 indirect costs in the grant budget; and

9 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Adult Probation Department is authorized to accept  
10 and expend a grant of technical assistance with a cash value of \$100,000 for the purpose of  
11 engaging in the Justice Reinvestment Initiative.
