Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Fire Department to retroactively accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$1,173,212 from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to develop and implement a Wellness and Fitness Program.

WHEREAS, Fire Department uniformed employees must maintain a high level of health and fitness so they are well prepared to respond to the over 100,000 calls for service that the Department receives annually; and

WHEREAS, City analysts found that Fire Department uniformed employees have a significant number of disability and workers compensation claims that may be due to stressful and unpredictable working conditions; strenuous lifting of heavy equipment and patients/victims; and sedentary periods followed by situations that require exertion; and,

WHEREAS, The Department offers certain health programs to its uniformed employees, including medical examinations, immunizations, infectious disease screening, audiograms, and behavioral health programs; and,

WHEREAS, Many Department Fire Stations have exercise equipment that does not meet current standards for maintaining physical fitness; and,

WHEREAS, A Wellness and Fitness Program would help mitigate the number of work-related injuries and lost work hours, reduce cardiovascular disease and the effects of aging among Fire Department uniformed employees, and support the Mayor's Executive Directive 05-11; and,

WHEREAS, The FEMA grant gives the City funding to increase the number of physical medical examinations provided to employees annually, to provide new fitness assessments

for uniformed employees, to train field employees as peer fitness trainers, and to purchase new exercise equipment for Fire Department facilities; and,

WHEREAS, The Fire Commission recommended approval of this grant at its meeting on March 13, 2008; and,

WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment; and,

WHEREAS, The grant requires the City to provide matching funds worth 20 percent of the total award, or \$293,303; and,

WHEREAS, The Fire Department proposes to maximize the use of the grant funds on program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Fire Department to accept and expend grant funds in the amount of \$1,173,212 from the Federal Emergency Management Agency; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chief of the Fire Department is hereby authorized and empowered to execute, deliver, and perform, in the name of the City and County of San Francisco, all applications, contracts, agreements, amendments, and payment requests necessary for the purpose of securing the FEMA grant funds and to implement and carry out the purposes specified in the applicable grant application.
