4 **the City and County of San Francisco et al. for \$380,000; the lawsuit was filed on June**
5 **11, 2019, in the United States District Court for the Northern District of California, Case**
6 **No. 4:19-cv-03260-YGR; entitled Frederick Schiff et al v. City and County of San**
7 **Francisco et al.; the lawsuit involves an employment dispute.**

9 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

10 Section 1. Pursuant to Charter Section 6.102(5), the Board of Supervisors hereby
11 authorizes the City Attorney to settle the action entitled Frederick Schiff et al. v. City and
12 County of San Francisco et al., United States District Court for the Northern District of
13 California, Case No. 4:19-cv-03260-YGR, by the payment of \$380,000. The lawsuit involves
14 an employment dispute.
