

1 [Provide SSI application assistance to the chronically homeless and mentally ill in San
2 Francisco.]

3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH) to**
4 **accept retroactively and expend a grant in the amount of \$97,660 from the Social**
5 **Security Administration (SSA) to provide SSI application assistance to the chronically**
6 **homeless and mentally ill in San Francisco and to enter into an agreement for the use**
7 **of these funds; for the period of May 1, 2006 to April 30, 2007.**

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9 WHEREAS, SFDPH has applied for and been awarded a grant from SSA in the
10 amount of \$97,660 to provide SSI application assistance to the chronically homeless and
11 mentally ill in San Francisco; and,

12 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, SSA requires the City to
13 comply with the terms of an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the
14 Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. _____, which is hereby declared to
15 be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

16 WHEREAS, The Department proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on
17 program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

18 RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept retroactively and expend a
19 grant in the amount of \$97,660 from SSA; and, be it

20 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of
21 indirect costs in the grant budget, and, be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept retroactively and
23 expend the grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Agreement,
24 pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code Section 10.170-1; and, be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
2 agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the position funded
4 under this agreement a "G" or grant-funded position which would terminate when the
5 agreement expires.
