

1 [Accept & Expend Grant - To support the Viral Load Study.]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) to accept**
4 **and expend retroactively a grant in the amount of \$15,055 from the Public Health**
5 **Foundation Enterprises (PHFE), to support a research project entitled “Viral Load**
6 **Study;” for the period of April 1, 2009 through March 31, 2010.**

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8 WHEREAS, PHFE is the recipient of a grant award from the Regents of the University
9 of California to support the research project entitled “Viral Load Study;” and,

10 WHEREAS, It is considered in the best interest of the Regents of the University of
11 California, PHFE, and DPH to collaborate on this project; and,

12 WHEREAS, Through this grant, PHFE has agreed to fund DPH in the amount of
13 \$15,055 for the period of April 1, 2009 through March 31, 2010; and,

14 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, PHFE requires the City to
15 enter into an agreement (the “Agreement”), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the
16 Board of Supervisors in File No. 091043_____; which is hereby declared to be a part of
17 this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

18 WHEREAS, An ASO amendment is not required as the grant partially reimburses DPH
19 for one existing position, Epidemiologist II (Job Class #2803) at .10 FTE, for the period of April
20 1, 2009 through March 31, 2010; and,

21 WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because DPH did not
22 receive the agreement from PHFE until July 24, 2009; and,

23 WHEREAS, The budget includes a provision for indirect costs of \$2,518; now
24 therefore, be it

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1 RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend a grant in the
2 amount of \$15,055 from PHFE; and, be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and
4 expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and,
5 be it

6 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
7 agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

8 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate all positions
9 funded under this agreement as "G" or grant-funded positions which would terminate when
10 the agreement expires.
