3 **Ordinance deleting Section 32.1.10 of the Traffic Code to remove restrictions on**
4 **parking on portions of Washington, Mason and Jackson Streets and to repeal the**
5 **corresponding penalties for violations.**

10 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

11 Section 1. The San Francisco Traffic Code is hereby amended by deleting Section
12 32.1.10, in its entirety:

13 ~~*Sec. 32.1.10. PARKING CONTROL, PORTIONS OF WASHINGTON, MASON AND JACKSON*~~
14 ~~*STREETS; PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.*~~

15 ~~*No person shall stop, park, or leave standing any vehicle, whether attended or unattended, at*~~
16 ~~*any time, on both sides of Washington Street from Mason Street to a point 210 feet westerly, south side*~~
17 ~~*of Jackson Street from Mason to a point 210 feet westerly, and the west side of Mason Street from*~~
18 ~~*Jackson to Washington, except an officer or employee of the City and County of San Francisco having*~~
19 ~~*a permit therefor issued by the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission and during the conduct of*~~
20 ~~*such officer or employee of the business of the City and County. Said Public Utilities Commission shall*~~
21 ~~*have authority to designate areas where various permittees shall be entitled to park or leave vehicles*~~
22 ~~*and no vehicles shall be parked or left in any area other than as so designated. Violation of this Section*~~
23 ~~*is an infraction and any vehicles stopped, parked, or left standing in any place prohibited by this*~~
24 ~~*Section is an obstruction to the free use of property and a nuisance within the meaning of Division 4,*~~
25 ~~*Part III of the Civil Code of California relating to nuisance and the abatement thereof.*~~
