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3 **Ordinance amending the Health Code Section 128, to retroactively increase patient**
4 **rates charged for certain mental health services.**

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10 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

11 Section 1. The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in
12 this ordinance comply with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public
13 Resources Code Section 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the
14 Board of Supervisors in File No. ____ and is incorporated herein by reference.

15 Section 2. The rates for certain mental health services are retroactive to reflect the
16 State's increases in reimbursement for these services.

17 Section 3. The Health Code is hereby amended by amending Section 128, to read as
18 follows:

19 **SEC. 128. PATIENT RATES.**

20 (a) The Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does hereby
21 determine and fix the proper reasonable amounts to be charged persons for services
22 furnished by the Department of Public Health as follows, which rates shall be effective for
23 services delivered as of July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2014.
